Jaime Jiménez, M.D., serves as Vice President of Southern Eye Center where he has devoted twelve years of service to the treatment and care of patients with sight threatening conditions such as diabetes and Macular Degeneration. Dr. Jiménez specializes in the management and treatment of retinal-vascular diseases, Retinal Detachments and eye inflammation. He completed two years of fellowship training in vitreo-retinal diseases and surgery and served as an assistant clinical professor of ophthalmology at the University of Texas at Houston. Dr. Jiménez also served as assistant chief of ophthalmology at Keesler Air Force Base in Biloxi, Mississippi where he received an Air Force Commendation Medal during his term of duty. He received his bachelor's and medical degrees from the University of Puerto Rico.

Dr. Jiménez is a fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology; the American Society of Retinal Surgeons, the Pan American Association of Ophthalmology, and was the President of the Southern Retinal Study Group. He is very active throughout his community and has been recognized for his involvement.
